#### **Venue:**

Dunton Bassett Arms

9, Bennetts Hill, Dunton Bassett, Lutterworth, Leicestershire LE17 5JJ

This is a village pub with good beer and an award winning Chinese Restaurant attached to it. The AGM will be held in the dining room of the restaurant. We will be starting at 2pm.

Please note that the pub does not serve food during the day so please eat before you get here. If this is going to be a massive problem let me know and the landlord will try and arrange for staff to be in at lunchtime.

We are planning on having a meal at the Chinese here in the evening so if you want to join in please let me know ASAP so that we can arrange numbers.

#### **Directions:**

##### **From the South:**

Leave the M1 at junction 20 for Lutterworth, turn left at the roundabout onto the A4303 signposted Lutterworth

At the next Roundabout (with a big plane in the middle of it) turn right onto the A426 signposted Leicester, Lutterworth. Follow this road through the town centre and keep going straight on. After about 4 miles you will enter Dunton Bassett carry on until you reach the traffic lights at the cross roads (these are the only traffic lights in Dunton Bassett). At the traffic lights turn left onto Coopers Lane then take the first left onto main street carry on past the post office and follow the road round to the right onto Bennetts Hill where the pub is.

##### **From the North**

Leave the M1 at J21 following the slip road to the left for the A5460. At the roundabout turn right onto the B4114 follow the road up past the Everards brewery on your left at the traffic lights turn left onto Soar Valley Way (A563) keeping the brewery on your left. Follow Soar Valley Way up to the big crossroads with traffic lights and turn right onto Lutterworth Road (A426) towards Glen Parva. Follow the road through Glen Parva at the County Arms traffic lights (with a derelict pub on your left) go straight on and under the railway bridge. Immediately after the bridge is a small roundabout, turn right here onto the Blaby bypass (A426) go straight on at the next 3 roundabouts following the A426. After

the 3<sup>rd</sup> roundabout the road will change from a dual carriageway to a single carriage way. Keep going straight on and after about 3 miles you will enter Dunton Bassett carry on until you reach the traffic lights at the cross roads (these are the only traffic lights in Dunton Bassett). At the traffic lights turn right onto Coopers Lane then take the first left onto main street carry on past the post office and follow the road round to the right onto Bennetts Hill where the pub is.

### **By Train:**

The nearest train station is Narborough although there are no direct transport links between here and Dunton Bassett. Otherwise take the train to Leicester station and get the number 84 bus to Lutterworth which goes through Dunton Bassett.
